I had the privilege of being invited to act as one of the opponents in the inaugural proceedings for the appointment of Associate Professor Doc. IUDr. Katarína Chovancová, PhD., LL.M., MCIArb. It was an honour for me to accept the invitation and to give my opinion.

Having examined her professional career, the relevant documents and papers, her main studies and the requirements for appointment as a professor, I have come to the following conclusions:

She is an internationally recognised expert in public international law, private international law and the law of international economic relations. She provides analyses of the most challenging issues in this field.

In recent years, she has devoted particular attention to both commercial and investment arbitration, analysing the latest case law of arbitral tribunals and the approach of ordinary courts to the recognition and enforcement of arbitral awards.
